



**CRUISER MILWAUKEE, USNSCC**  
**SAFETY PROTOCOLS – COVID 19 PROCEDURES FOR IN-PERSON DRILLS**  
**(These comply with USNSCC COVID-19 Safety Protocols – a copy may be found on our website)**

**Application Period:** These procedures are effective immediately (22JUN21) and will stay in place until further notice.

**Attestation Document:** Each Cadet and Staff Member on the morning of the first day of drill for a single day event or consecutive drills. For our Unit, this means one (1) document per weekend, handed in at arrival time on Saturday morning.

**Vaccinations:** If Cadets, Parents and/or Staff were vaccinated and wish to provide proof, a mask will not be required at drill but, you must provide proof. Providing such proof, is a personal decision and we respect that decision.

- If you wish to provide proof of vaccinations, you must provide us a copy of the vaccination card and resubmit the Medical History Form (pages 3 and 4) with a note in Box 9 stating the vaccination date.

**Masks:** Masks are no longer required for vaccinated persons. However, if Cadets, Parents and/or Staff have been vaccinated but still feel more comfortable wearing a mask, on a volunteer basis, you should feel free to make this decision on your own. Parents who wish for their Cadet to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status, is a Parental choice, and we respect that ... simply do not provide proof of vaccination and your Cadet will be considered unvaccinated, and we will enforce the following mask criteria.

- A. Indoors:
  - a. For non-vaccinated members, follow CDC, state, and local guidelines as appropriate.
  - b. Unvaccinated adults and cadets should wear masks indoors
- B. Outdoors:
  - a. When outdoors, cadets and adults are not required to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status.
  - b. Cadets should not be kept at parade rest or attention for long periods if wearing masks.

**Muster/Check-in General Instructions:**

- Completed NSCC COVID-19 Attestation document on file or delivered to a Staff Member before the Parent departs.
- Temperature checks are no longer required upon arrival.
- Parents of Cadets who exhibit any COVID or flu-like symptoms during drill shall be notified as soon as practicable.
